#### **MINISTER'S REFLECTION:**

As we enter March this year, we enter into the season of Lent. Lent is our time as Christians for recalibration: for reviewing and where necessary resetting our lives. It is our time for spiritual Spring-cleaning. Every year in the United States, the President gives a State of the Union address ('SOTU' in Capitol Hill parlance) to a joint session of Congress, reviewing the year past and surveying the year ahead. Last year, it was delivered by President Biden on March 7th, but it can be held at any time from early January. Each of us can benefit from a SOTU-style review of ourselves from time to time, an update on how we're doing, a taking of our temperatures, which can extend to our whole life situation: where we've got to, where we're going, and so on. It's a chance to take stock and to see what could or should be amended or changed. Lent, coming as it does each year in the Spring, lends itself to the spiritual side of this equivalent of an MOT. And of course, as Christians we are taught that this 'spiritual side' affects and impacts everything else. Lent presents us therefore with a precious six week opportunity – an opportunity to embrace again this year and to make the most of.
