



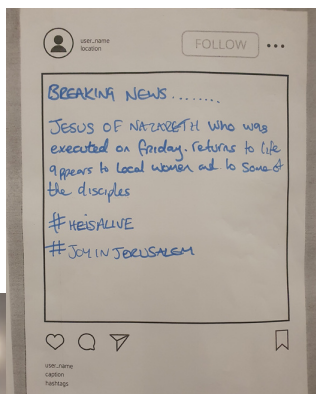
Gorbals Church Chat
